C. <u>Schlechty</u> moved and <u>Harrison</u> seconded that the Board of Education approve the Wee Patriot Preschool Handbook for the 2009-2010 school year, retro-active to August 31, 2009, as recommended by the Superintendent.

The following tuition fees have been established for each session:

Session IA – This program designed for children who will be 3 years of age by Sept. 30. Classes will be held on Tuesday and Thursday from 8:30 a.m.–11:30 a.m. at a cost of \$765 a year.

Session IB – This is an all day class from 8:30–2:30 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday at a cost of \$1,215 a year. This option will include a lunch period and rest time.

Session IIA – This program is designed for children who will be 4 years of age or older by Sept.30. Classes will be held Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:30–11:30 a.m. at a cost of \$945 a year

Session IIB – This is an all day class from 8:30 a.m.–2:30 p.m. Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at a cost of \$1,665. This option will include a lunch period and rest time.

Session III – This program is also designed for children 4 years of age or older by Sept. 30. Classes will be held on Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m.–2:30 p.m. each day. This option will include a Lunch period and rest time. The cost will be \$2,340 a year.

Before & After Care – This program is \$2.00/hr and times will be established at the beginning of each school year.
