



## **Board of Education Vacancy Announcement**

May 18, 2017

New Madison- There will be a vacancy on the Tri-Village Board of Education effective June 15, due to the resignation of Kevin Harrison (change in residence) thus, the remaining board members have 30 days to fill the vacancy.

The Board of Education is seeking applicants to fulfill the vacated term through December 31, 2017. If the appointed candidate wishes to continue service on the school board, they will stand for election in the next general election (November 7, 2017).

Citizens interested in being considered for appointment to the Tri-Village Board of Education should direct their attention to the district website ([www.tri-village.k12.oh.us](http://www.tri-village.k12.oh.us)) or pick up an application packet at the Board of Education office. The deadline for submission is Monday, June 19.

According to the Ohio School Boards Association, people serving on school boards in Ohio must be at least 18 years old, district residents and registered voters.

President, Tim Bevins said the board will review all applications and decide on the replacement at its June 26 board of education meeting.
