I'm pleased to announce an exciting trip coming up during the summer of 2011 for any interested students or anyone from the Tri-Village School family. From **June 6 to June 15, 2011**, we will explore **Dublin, London, and Paris** on an EF Educational Tour.

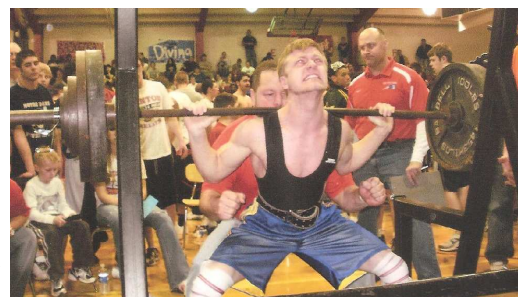
