Data Goals

The District will have:

1. 90% of all 3rd grade students scoring proficient (700) or above on the 3rd grade ELA state assessment.
2. 80% of all 5th grade students scoring proficient or above on the 5th grade math state assessment.
3. 80% of all 6th grade students scoring proficient or above on the 6th grade math state assessment.
4. 85% of all 7th grade students scoring proficient or above on the 7th grade math state assessment.
5. 85% of all 8th grade ELA students scoring proficient or above on the 8th grade ELA state assessment.
6. 80% of all Geometry students scoring proficient or above on the Geometry state assessment.
7. 96% of all 9th grade students successfully earn Algebra I and English 9 credit.
8. 96% of all 9th grade students pass 5.5 high school credits which include math, science and language arts.
9. met 90% of the indicators assessed by the Department of Education and Workforce.

Instructional Goals

The District will have:

1. 100% of all teaching staff create and submit two SMART goals by September 3rd to building administrators.
2. 100% of all teaching staff select two pieces of High-Quality Student Data for OTES 2.0 by September 3rd.
3. each teacher will engage their students in at least two different career connection experiences that relate to the content being taught.
