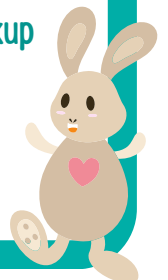

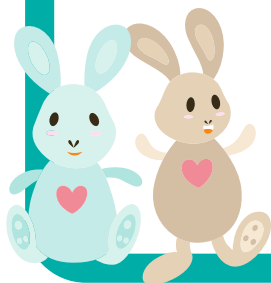

News from Officer Dan

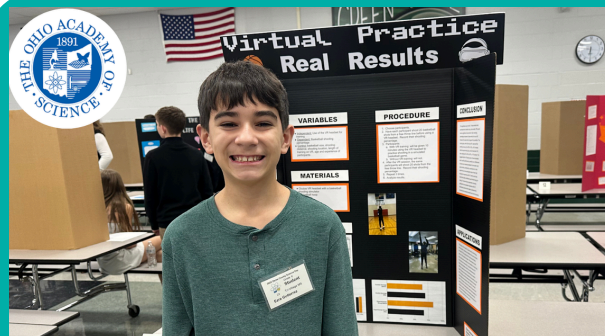
CHANGES TO DROP OFF LINE REMINDERS:

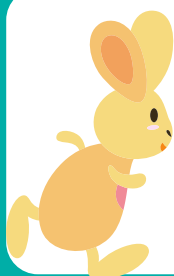

It is located by the exit to the elementary playgrounds.

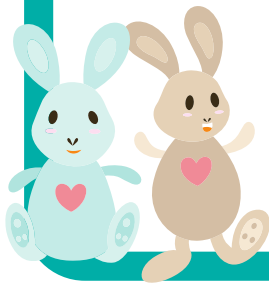


Preschool Registration
