

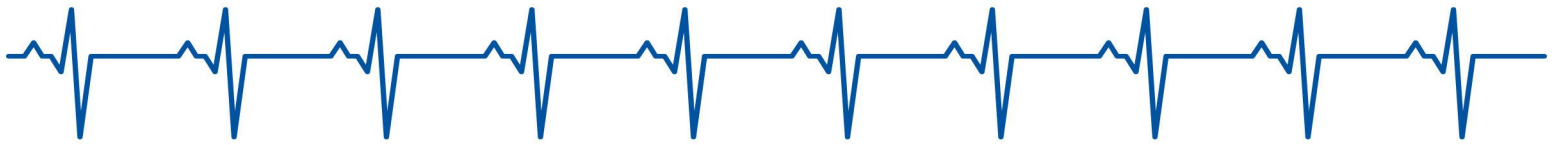

A message from the Superintendent

Tri-Village Local Schools will be implementing an energy conservation project this spring which will improve the learning environment while saving \$60,520 in annual energy costs. Superintendent Josh Sagester explains, "We continue to look at all avenues to reduce our operating costs so we can direct our taxpayer dollars into the classrooms for our students." No new taxes will be required and no levy will appear on the ballot, as the project costs will be paid for through the utility savings.

The project will be designed and implemented by Energy Optimizers, USA, an energy services company based in Tipp City, and will mainly involve upgrading existing fixtures – not replacing what the district has already invested in. Rapid technology advancement in lighting, LED, and building automation and controls make it feasible to update the school facilities now in a thoughtful, intentional way.

The following upgrades will be made as part of this project:

- Interior and exterior LED lighting
- Building automation system upgrades
- Kitchen walk-in temperature controls
- Dynamic air filtration systems

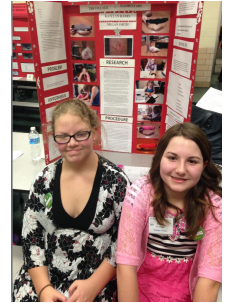
The annual energy savings of \$60,520 is the equivalent of saving 146 acres of trees and removing 95 cars from the road!

After project completion, Energy Optimizers, USA will assist the district's staff and students in starting an energy education "green team" program to engage students in STEM-based curriculum, perform fun "green" team-building activities, and provide exposure to STEM careers.

We'll keep you posted as this project begins. There will be no disruption to the educational environment while the contractors are working in our facilities. In the meantime, please call Superintendent Sagester if you'd like more information.

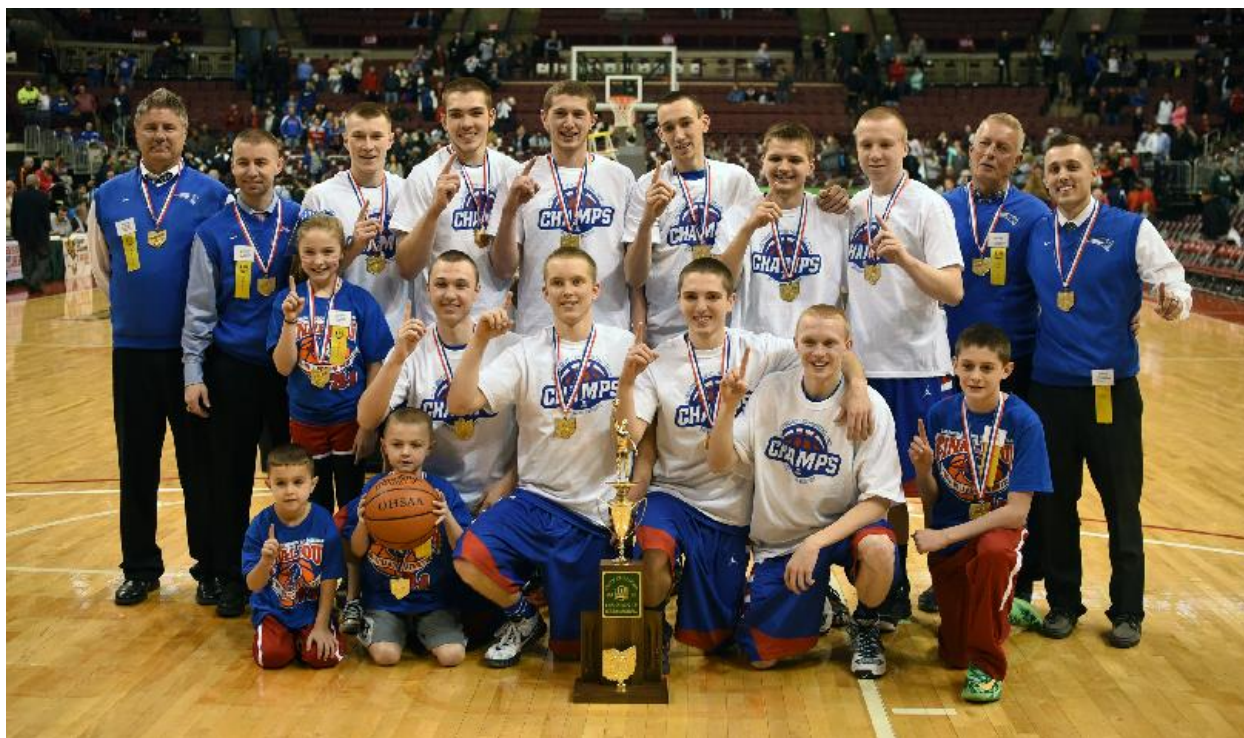
2015 SENIOR YEARBOOK
