SIGNING YOUR STUDENT OUT

Parents please remember to bring your ID's when checking out your students. Any individual picking up a student must have an ID and be on the list to pick up on Final Forms either on the medical form or the transportation form.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE

Students that are walking or transported by parents will enter and exit on the north side of the school. Students should not arrive before 7:45 A.M. If a student arrives after 8:10 A.M. he/she will need to report to the office and sign in as "tardy." Parents are not to block the school's entrance by parking their cars in the drop off zone or blocking other cars. Please pull in the parking lot to wait for your student, we ask you to please drive slowly and with caution. No K-6 students are allowed to be dropped off in front of the Early Learning Center or the PAC (Patriot Activity Center) in the northeast parking lot of campus. All parents have to enter the Main Street entrance and go through the Elementary pick up line and exit accordingly.

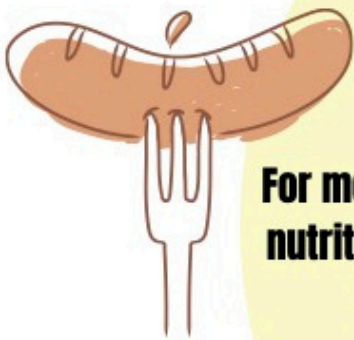
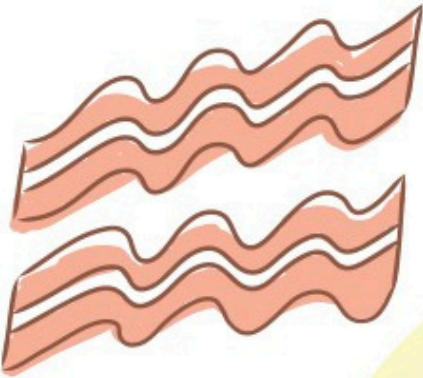
