

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## **COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS**

- College Credit Plus (CCP) gives high school students the opportunity to take college courses and receive college credit for free, while still in high school.
  1. Courses can be taken on the college campus (of the colleges we have partnered with)
  2. Courses can be taken online (with colleges we have partnered with)
  3. Courses can be taken at Tri-Village (and taught by Tri-Village teachers)
- Benefits for students
  1. Earn high school and college credit
  2. Have the option of completing college courses on our campus
  3. Get a head start in completing a degree
- Eligibility Requirements
  1. Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year all Ohio public high schools and public colleges and universities are required to participate in this program, and so every student will have the chance to apply. You must meet certain course completion or test score requirements to show that you are academically ready for classes; contact the CCP program or speak with a high school guidance counselor for more information.



### **-English and Social Studies-**


1. Successful completion of two units of College Prep English/Language Arts with a minimum of a B average and the high school's recommendation, OR an ACT score of 18 in English and 21 in Reading, or score college ready on college placement testing.

### **- Math and Science-**

1. Successful completion of Algebra II or its equivalent with a minimum of a B average and the high school's recommendation, OR an ACT score of 22 in Math, or score college ready on college placement testing.

- **CCP transfer**

1. Most CCP credits will transfer to any public Ohio colleges and universities
2. Students should contact specific colleges to verify transferring credits
