Brody Beisner competed in the FFA Creed Speaking contest, placing 2nd and qualifying for the District 5 Contest next week against all of the surrounding counties!

If Brody places in the Top 2 at the district level, he will be only the 2nd Speaker in our chapter's history to qualify for the state contest, the first being Willow Moore just a few years ago.
