

Wee Patriot Preschool

Preschool is a very important beginning to any child's education. Studies have shown that children who attend preschool usually have a better school experience and are socially, emotionally and academically more prepared for Kindergarten. Tri-Village School District recently received a government grant that will allow us to offer a preschool option for preschoolers whose families qualify under the Federal Poverty Guidelines. As of right now, the class would run from 11:30-2:30 Monday-Friday. Free and reduced lunches would also be available based on financial basis. Below are the guidelines for free and reduced tuition.


For family units with more than 8 members, add \$4,160 for each family member.

The sliding scale fee is based on income and size of family. If according to family size, your income falls in Column A, your child's tuition will be free. If your income falls in Column B, your child's tuition will be reduced by 2/3 each month. If your income falls in Column C, your child's tuition will be reduced by 1/3 each month. If your income falls in Column D, your child's tuition will not be reduced. If your income falls in Column A, B or C please pick up a form from the preschool and return it by March 18, 2016.

Tri-Village Elementary School is announcing the Kindergarten registration for the 2016-2017 school year. Registration packets will be available starting March 7th in the elementary office daily from 7:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. If you cannot come during this time frame, please call the elementary office as soon as possible so that we can make arrangements for you to receive the necessary information.

Children being registered for Kindergarten **must be five years of age** by August 1, 2016 in order to be eligible for enrollment. Parents should bring a copy of the child's birth certificate (must be original) and custody papers (if that applies). Please plan on spending a few minutes completing the necessary registration paperwork.
