WHEREAS, the OFCC determined that the Board's findings were reasonable and the OFCC approved the Board's request for approval to incur indebtedness to finance such energy conservation measures; and
WHEREAS, the Board authorized approval of such debt issuance pursuant to a resolution adopted by this Board on June 29, 2015; and
WHEREAS, at such meeting on June 29, 2015, only three members of the Board were in attendance and therefore the Board would like to adopt legislation clearly establishing the Board's intent that division (A) of Revised Code Section 3313.46 does not apply to the installation, modification, or remodeling involved in the energy conservation measures.
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Tri-Village Local School District (the "District"), County of Darke, Ohio:
SECTION 1. That the Board hereby declares, by at least a two-third vote of all of its members, that division (A) of Revised Code Section 3313.46 does not apply to the installation, modification, or remodeling involved in the energy conservation measures undertaken pursuant division (G) of Section 133.06 of the Revised Code. SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.
