# Message from the Superintendent Winter Sports Team and Individual Awards

As you know, the calamity day saga in the State of Ohio has finally been resolved. The amended Substitute House Bill 416 passed both Houses of Congress and was signed by Governor John Kasich on Wednesday, March 26. The approved legislation allows districts to amend the 2013-2014 contingency plans. Therefore, the district would like to give you an update as to where we stand regarding our current contingency plan. As it stands, the Tri-Village Local School District is left with two calamity days to make up; one from a snow day on February 18 and the second from the cancellation of school on March 21 for the Boys State Basketball tournament.

The plan for the makeup days is as follows.

The first day will be made up using a series of thirty -minute extensions to **eleven** school days prior to Spring Ohio Achievement Assessments. These thirty-minute extensions will be applied on the following school days: April 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, and 25. OAA will begin on Tuesday, April 29. The second of the school days will be made up on Friday, May 30.

The administration and Board of Education believe this is a sound plan that will provide our students more instructional

time in the classroom and will allow our faculty to fulfill their contractual obligations. As always, the district appreciates the continued support as we near the end of another successful school year.
