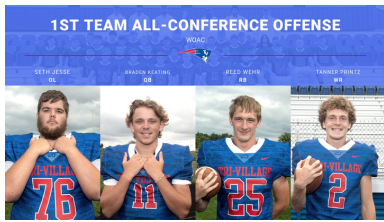

The FFA Soils Teams Compete at State Finals

Our teams travelled to Lancaster, OH to compete in the State Finals on 10/14/2023. This is the Top 50 teams in each division from across the state. (400 chapters in Ohio)

The Urban Team placed 11th overall lead by Lucas Howell (14th) and Kiersten Wilcox (36th). First year evaluator Leana Metzcar placed (91st) and Darcy Miller (102nd). There were 164 Urban contestants at the State Finals.

The Ag/Rural Team placed 28th. Macy Howell (49), Josh Metzcar (111), Hunter Ridout (121) and Alexa Light (156). There were 181 Ag/Rural contestants in the State Finals.

We will miss our seniors as Josh Metzcar is a 2 time State Qualifier. Kiersten Willcox and Macy Howell are 3 time State Qualifiers, both playing roles on Top 10 teams! But, we never rebuild, we just reload!
