	and the District's Transportation Supervisor, with both roles being vital to the District;
	WHEREAS, the Board's legal counsel has advised that it would be in the District's best interest to ensure that
	Gerald Hollinger remain in an exempt administrative position under the FLSA; and
	WHEREAS , the Board already has in Gerald Hollinger a qualified person filling an exempt Transportation Supervisor position.
