FFA teams travelled to Lancaster, OH to compete in the State Finals. This is the Top 50 teams in each division from across the state. (400 chapters in Ohio)

The Urban Team placed 11th overall lead by <u>Lucas</u> <u>Howell (14th)</u> and Kiersten Wilcox (36th). First year evaluator Leana Metzcar placed (91st) and Darcy Miller (102nd). There were 164 Urban contestants at the State Finals.

The Ag/Rural Team placed 28th. Macy Howell (49), Josh Metzcar (111), Hunter Ridout (121) and Alexa Light (156). There were 181 Ag/Rural contestants in the State Finals.
