

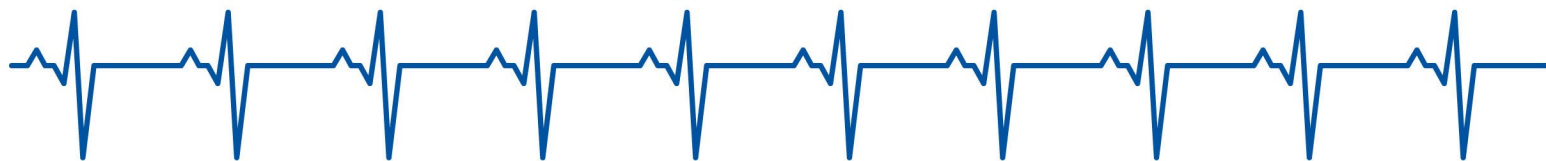

U.S. News & World Report Recognizes Tri-Village Local Schools among the 2024 Best Elementary, Junior High and High Schools

Washington, D.C. – December 13, 2023 – Tri-Village Junior High and Elementary Schools has been ranked among the 2024 Best Elementary and Junior High Schools by U.S. News & World Report. The rankings include more than 79,000 public elementary and junior high schools across the country.

"We are extremely proud of our students, staff, and community as both Tri-Village Elementary School and Junior High School earned "badges" of excellence through the U.S. News & World Report rankings, said Josh Sagester, District Superintendent.

The [methodology](#) focuses on state assessments of students who were proficient or above proficient in mathematics and reading/language arts while accounting for student backgrounds, achievement in core subjects, and how well schools are educating their students. Student-teacher ratios are applied to break ties in the overall score. The 2024 Best Elementary and Best Junior High Schools rankings are based on publicly available data from the U.S. Department of Education.

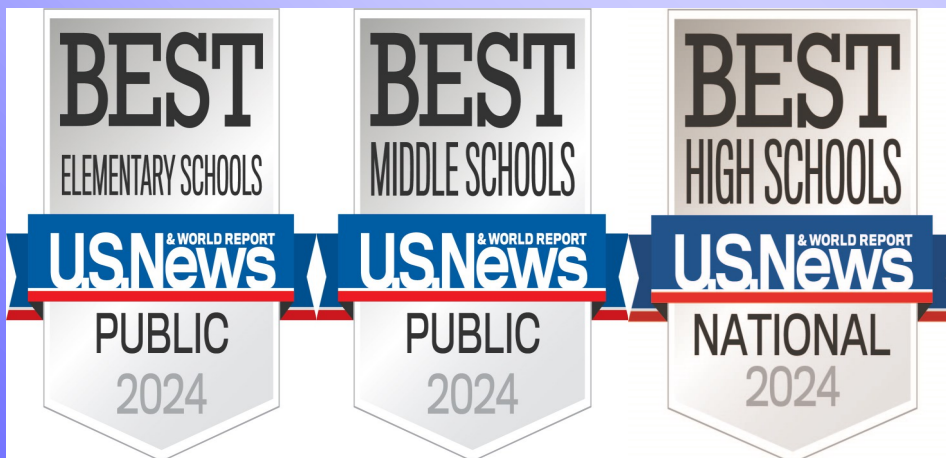
