



# Tri-Village Local Schools

The Tri-Village Local School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, July 27, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Tim Bevins, Shane Coby, Tracy Frech and Tom Schlechty. Amy Farmer attended virtually. Josh Sagester and Kim Chowning were present as well. The minutes of the regular meeting for June 29, 2020 were approved as well as the Special Education IDEA Part B funds special meeting minutes. The members also approved the June 2020 expenditures and all financial reports as presented by the Treasurer. Visitors included Stephanie Baumgardner, Michelle Groff, Jodi Fritz and Tabitha Justice. Superintendent Sagester introduced Mrs. Baumgardner and Mrs. Groff to the B.O.E. members. The ladies exited the meeting after their introduction.

Superintendent Report: Mr. Sagester shared, reviewed and discussed the school reopening plan with the Board of Education members. Mrs. Jodi Fritz, School Nurse, was in attendance as well to assist in answering any questions brought forward. The document was reviewed until approximately 7:20 at which time the District’s attorney, Tabitha Justice, provided a current events legal update emphasizing recent COVID orders’ interpretations until 8:22. Sagester proceeded with his report at this time. The District is looking at a few different options for the annual open house and are hoping that the students and parents will have an opportunity to visit their classrooms. Per Ohio Revised Code 3313.814, the District’s food service program has adopted and continues to enforce a nutrition standards policy (policy numbers 8500 & 8500A). An additional part-time custodian may be hired to help with the enhanced cleaning duties required during the school day. Concrete will be poured, and framing should begin soon for the bus garage. The Ohio High School Athletic Association has released “return to play” guidelines. A copy of the guidelines was emailed to the members.
