2. Recommend to approve the following resolution authorizing an unvoted permanent improvement levy (R.C. Sections 5705.314, 5705.06 and 5705.09):

WHEREAS, a permanent improvement is defined under Ohio Revised Code ("Revised Code") 5705.01(E) as any property, asset or improvement with an estimated life or usefulness of five years or more; and

WHEREAS, the School District is authorized by law to acquire, construct or improve a specific permanent improvement or any class of permanent improvements which could be included in a single bond issue; and

WHEREAS, in its budget for Fiscal Year 2024 (2023-2024) and thereafter, the Board will have identified the need for certain permanent improvements (the "Permanent Improvements") for the School District, particularly maintaining current facilities, structural and mechanical operations, general maintenance, grounds upkeep and new construction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Tri-Village Local School District, Darke County, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The Board shall levy a 1.2 mill unvoted permanent improvement levy for Tax Collection Year 2023 to fund the Permanent Improvements. Such levy shall be included in the Tax Budget for Fiscal Year 2024 and thereafter.
- Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all

deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.
